- *Anguilla* - The friendliest island in the Leeward Island group. A long, skinny island, a 20-minute ferry boat ride from St. Maarten filled with gorgeous beaches, perfect for sun lovers.
- *St. Barts* - The most chic, glamorous, sophisticated French island in the Leeward Island group. Loaded with beautiful celebrities, great restaurants and resorts with prices to match but it's possible to find a few doable surprises, a 15-minute flight from St. Martin airport.
- *Carriacou*, an off-the-beaten tourist path, a 10-minute flight from Grenada. A beachcomber's heaven with a few really affordable and simple accommodations. Definitely not for celebrity spotters or night life aficionados.
- *Terre-de-Haut*, a tiny island that is part of the Iles des Saintes in the French Antilles, off the coast of Guadeloupe. Getting here is only for the adventurous with patience for airports, boats and schedules. For some, it's worth it, it's a gorgeous hilly island with outstanding views, beaches, great Creole and French Food. The little bay looks like a miniature Rio de Janeiro.
